Election Position Descriptions and Requirements

***COLLEGE SENATE ***10 undergraduate positions available, One year term

The College Senate is the official agency through which faculty, staff and students engage in the governance of the College. The Senate advises the President of the College on a variety of topics including the following:

- a. Curriculum,
- b. Instruction and research;
- c. Standards for admission, retention, and graduation of students;
- d. Appointment, termination, promotion of faculty and to define "consultation" in selecting department chairpersons and deans;
- e. By-laws and elections;
- f. Budget and staff allocations;
- g. Student welfare;
- h. Academic plan;
- i. Public service activities;
- j. Academic services;
- k. International education.

The College Senate is composed of:

- a. The President
- b. Three Vice Presidents
- c. Nine Faculty at large
- d. Six Professionals at large
- e. Eighteen (six from each) faculty one Butler Library faculty
- f. One State University Senator

g. Ten students elected by the student body whose terms of office and method of election shall be determined in accordance with the United Students' Government Constitution

h. Two appointed by the President

In order to be a candidate for this position the following requirements must be fulfilled:

- Must hold a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0.
- Currently be a matriculated undergraduate student enrolled for a minimum of nine (9).
